

## Description

The Opportunity Zone Program is an effort by the Federal Government to spur new or increased investments in low-income communities. It is based on 25% of the census tracts identified as 'Low Income Communities' by the Community Development Financial Institutions Fund (CDFI Fund), a division of the US Department of the Treasury. Capital Gains from private holdings, which are invested in Qualified Opportunity Funds that in turn invest in designated Opportunity Zones, can see significant tax benefits. Please consult with your tax professional for full details.

These tracts were selected by the Louisiana Governor's Office in April of 2018.
