# LWI Project Inventory FAQ

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## What is the project inventory?

A list of projects that are either planned, underway, or recently completed within the watershed to create a holistic regional picture.

## Why is it important to include your project?

Having a comprehensive regional list will enable discussions on how to coordinate and collaborate on capital projects and programs in order to achieve the best flood risk reduction outcomes.

## Is our project too small to list?

Projects with localized impact, like small-scale infrastructure do not need to be included. If your project demonstrates a unique approach to the problem of flood-risk or uses a new material or technology, it is likely worth including for the sake of sharing with regional stakeholders.

## Our project has multiple parts do we list it multiple times?

- Annual and ongoing flood risk reduction activities like waterway dredging, drainage pipes point repairs, or pump station operation can be entered as a single project.
- Capital improvement programs with multiple similar individual projects i.e. drainage repairs can be grouped by geography or other characteristics can be entered as a single project.

## How do I submit information?

For Region 8 projects you can send your data to the Regional Planning Commission. We will submit your data on the Region 8 ArcGIS webform. If you have questions or would like to submit your project information please contact the RPC.

## What information is required when we submit a project?

- **Project Point of Contact**
- **Project Name & Owner**
- **Project Type & General Details**
- **Project Location**
- **Brief Overview of Project Elements**
- **Current Project Status**
- **Estimated Cost & Funding Status**
- **If Applicable Related Study or Plans**

## Keep in mind:

Inclusion of a project on the online form and/or viewer is not an indication that funding will be provided to any particular project. This dataset is to increase public awareness of a broad range of proposed watershed project development activities.
