Agreement with Federal Highway Administration-- Eastern Federal Lands Highway Division's Federal Lands Access Program Project Grant.

Introduced by_____, seconded by ______, on the 12th day of September, 2023.

Whereas, the Regional Planning Commission for Jefferson Orleans, Plaquemines, St. Bernard, St. Charles, St. John the Baptist, St. Tammany and Tangipahoa Parishes (hereinafter known as RPC) staff worked in partnership with Federal Highway Administration to facilitate an application for Action Plan funding from the Federal Lands Access grant program (hereinafter known as the FLAP), Section 11113 of the Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act (Pub. L. 117–58, November 15, 2021; also referred to as the "Bipartisan Infrastructure Law" or "BIL"); and

Whereas, the RPC is designated as the Metropolitan Planning Organization to 23 USC 134(b)(2) and 23 CFR 450.310, and was an eligible applicant for the FLAP grant, agreeing to take the lead to apply for the FLAP grant, and

Whereas, the Federal Lands Access program is intended to conduct feasibility, environmental, and project development for improving recreational access to, and within, the Bayou Sauvage National Wildlife Refuge, with an emphasis on bicycle and pedestrian facilities.; and

Whereas, pursuant to FLAP federal program guidance, projects and initiatives derived from said plan will enable eligibility for federal FLAP Implementation funding (also in Section 11113 of the Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act), to be pursued by the parish and/or local jurisdictions, while providing veracity and standing when pursuing other federal funding program sources for identified projects or initiatives; and

Whereas, the Federal Lands Access Program application requested \$300,000 in federal funds (100% of the total cost); and

Whereas, Article VII, Sec. 14(C) of the Louisiana Constitution of 1974 provides that for a public purpose, the State and its political subdivisions or political corporations may engage in cooperative endeavors with each other or with any other private association, corporation, or individuals; and

Whereas, the USDOT awarded the RPC's FLAP grant request on December 8, 2022 and it is incumbent on RPC to enter into a cooperative endeavor agreement with Federal Highway Administration Office to fulfill obligations to administer the grant; and

Whereas, the RPC using national best practices and guidance provided by United States Department of Transportation, and working with the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service, RPC will develop a scope of work to accomplish the goals outlined within the FLAP notice of funding opportunity; and

Now, therefore be it resolved, That RPC hereby authorizes the RPC Chairman or the Executive Director to enter into a Cooperative Endeavor Agreement with the U.S. Department of Transportation Federal Highway Administration Office for the FLAP Grant in the amount of \$300,000 to complete the activities described in the Article 3 summary project information contained within the grant agreement.

Further that, this agreement shall remain in full force and effect until January 30, 2025 or as otherwise extended or modified in writing by the parties hereto.
